2. You MUST have a permit-to-work (PTW) of the appropriate type(s) issued to you or your supervisor before undertaking ANY work on site.

You MUST remain within the agreed scope of work and use the agreed methods. ANY change MUST be reviewed with the responsible company personnel.

You MUST comply with all stipulations on your permit. If you think these are impractical, tell the person issuing the permit or review them with a responsible company person.

- 3. You MUST NOT bring any equipment, other than unpowered hand tools, into plant areas except as permitted under your PTW.
